Two original WCC faculty members, a four-time interim Dean, an administrative assistant, an alumna with a successful preschool education career, and a public agency that supports foster children, will be honored at a dinner and ceremony Friday, March 11, in the Woodland Community College Community Room, 2300 E. Gibson Road, Building 800, in Woodland.

The 2015-16 honorees include original faculty members Jim Lawson and the late Lee Mitchell; WCC graduate and preschool operator and community volunteer Tania Garcia-Cadena; and retired administrative assistant Sunny Foster. The Foundation also will honor former Woodland Mayor Marlin "Skip" Davies, who after retiring as an administrator in the Los Rios Community College District, has been a four-time interim dean for Woodland Community College.

Furthermore First Five Yolo is being recognized for its vital financial support of the College's Foster Care and Kinship Education program. First Five Yolo focuses resources on Yolo County's children ages 0-5. Board chairman is Yolo County supervisor Jim Provenza and the executive director is Gina Daleiden.

Proceeds from the Dinner support WCC programs for student success, with a priority this year being to ensure adequate reserves for the newly-created Dorothy Minges Student Emergency Fund. This fund was established last fall in honor of the late Dorothy Minges, a former Woodland teacher and longtime member of the Yuba Community College Foundation and its local affiliate, the Woodland Community College Foundation.

Gary Sandy, Yuba Community College Trustee representing Woodland and current Board President, will once again emcee the program, which will celebrate each honoree's contributions to the growth of Woodland Community College.
