## Eligibility Criteria for FWS

2. Must meet the same eligibility requirements as required for Pell.
3. Must be enrolled as a regular student in an eligible program of study (working towards a certificate or degree).
4. Must have a high school diploma, GED, or equivalent.
5. Must be meeting satisfactory academic progress standards.
