Thank you for your interest in Yuba Community College District campuses — Yuba College-Marysville, CA; Clear Lake Campus-Clearlake CA; and, Woodland Community College-Woodland, CA. Attached is an International Student Admission Application packet to apply for admission as an International Student. We are now accepting applications for Spring Semester, all application materials MUST be on file in this office on or before the deadline date of December 1. If you prefer to apply for Fall Semester, application materials MUST be on file in this office on or before the deadline of May 15.

Please review the Checklist of required Application Documents carefully.

All applicants whose native language is not English MUST take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). Yuba Community College District Campuses minimum TOEFL score requirement for the Written test is 475; for the Computer-based test is 152; and for the Internet-based test is 53. Your International Student Admission Application will not be considered without official TOEFL scores on file. It is essential that you schedule to take the test well in advance of testing. Official TOEFL Test scores must be submitted directly to Woodland Community College (School Code: 5762) from the Educational Testing Service. For information about when and where the TOEFL is given, you may write to TOEFL, Box 6151, Princeton, NJ 08541-6151, USA, or call 1-609-771-7100, or visit their website at: www.ets.org/toefl

We estimate that the annual tuition, books and general living expenses for attending a Yuba Community College District Campus (from August to June) at approximately \$13,000.00. If you are planning a one-year course of study you will need to provide funding documentation of \$13,000.00 (minimum); for a two-year course of study, you will need funding documentation of \$26,000.00 (minimum); please see the Expenses Sheet enclosed. There are no scholarships or financial aid programs available at Yuba Community College District Campuses for international students. We require each student applicant to complete the attached Confidential Financial Information form and provide a certified letter and current bank statement from his/her sponsor's bank verifying that sufficient funds translated to U.S. Dollars are available to meet his/her school tuition and living expenses while attending the college. If you are accepted to attend Yuba Community College District, you are required to carry your own health insurance and to provide a copy of proof of health care coverage to the International Student Representative at the Woodland Community College.

Yuba Community College District Campuses <u>do not</u> have on-campus dormitories -- students must make their own living arrangements while attending Yuba Community College District.
