STUDENT AMBASSADOR JOB DESCRIPTION

Goals and Objectives

The WCC Student Ambassador program is a method for providing leadership experience for students and tangible support for WCC functions. Student Ambassadors are offered special opportunities to explore their leadership and service potentials through an accelerated personal and professional development program. Ambassadors serve in a variety of capacities and participate in training opportunities unique to a community college setting.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Student Ambassador program, students must:

- ➤ Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
 The GPA will be determined by their most recent WCC transcript.
- You must have been a WCC student for at least 1 semester prior to applying. (at least 12 units)
- ➤ Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- ➤ Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- > Have a willingness to be a student ambassador for two consecutive semesters.

Ambassadors must maintain a caring, service-oriented attitude with respect to the college and program objectives. This attitude is represented in a willingness to attend all program training sessions and serve in capacities deemed appropriate by the program Coordinator.

Continued academic progress toward each student's goal is central to the philosophy of the Student Ambassador program. Students are encouraged to apply only if they believe the program and service commitment will enhance their educational goals without hindering academic progress.

Conduct

Student Ambassadors are student representatives of WCC. They enjoy unique leadership opportunities and special advantages for personal enrichment and professional development. Student Ambassadors are expected to conduct themselves as campus leaders, exhibiting the behavior expected of a college representative. Students should exhibit a service-oriented attitude, a desire to meet and greet campus visitors, and a willingness to assist campus guests and prospective students interested in WCC. Personal grooming, attitude, habits, and speaking ability should be of the highest caliber.

College Duties

Student Ambassadors perform various duties and services as a WCC representative. Their duties include, but are not limited to leading the WCC campus tours, ushering events, representing the college in outreach capacities, meeting and greeting campus visitors, and attending mandatory student leadership and training sessions.
