- ASCCC Accreditation Institute is scheduled for February. WCC will be sending a team.
- There was a listening webinar session from ACCJC led by Dr. Richard Winn. He outlined some of the changes that have been made at ACCJC regarding leadership and officially appointing various VPs of ACCJC to serve as direct liaisons with college districts. Also, shared a number of initiatives to help streamline expectations for the Accreditation process and new trainings for team chairs and team members who serve on site visits to colleges.
