

# TRiO Student Support Services SSS & SSS-ESL



The goal of TRiO is to increase the college retention and graduation rates of its participants. The TRiO programs provide its participants with a variety of <u>FREE</u> services including:

- Counseling services
- Priority Registration
- Advice and assistance in postsecondary course selection
- Information on financial aid & financial literacy
- Guidance as student research, applies, and transition to four-year institutions
- Cultural events and campus tours

## Who's eligible for TRiO?

Students who are:

- (a) U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- (b) Pursuing a degree, and
- (c) Currently enrolled in 8 or more units at Woodland Community College/Colusa County Campus (ESL)
- (d) You also need to meet one or more of the following criteria:
  - 1. Be a first generation college student (neither parent has received a four-year college degree)
  - 2. Meet federal low-income guidelines (as determined by the federal government)
  - 3. Have a documented disability.

## **Selection Process**

Only complete applications from eligible students will be reviewed. After the initial screening, eligible applicants will be invited to a short interview with project staff. In a competitive situation, priority will be given to applicants who demonstrate (1) the greatest need for support and (2) the strongest desire to be an active and engaged TRiO scholar. Space is limited and students are highly encouraged to submit applications as soon as possible.
