To begin this cultural and institutional transformation to make our colleges student-ready, each college was invited to complete and submit the California Community College Guided Pathways Self-Assessment Tool (Self- Assessment). <u>Committee</u> Charge	 Student Success Committee Provide leadership to the College as we undertake the requisite pathways self-assessment, making implementation recommendations to the Senate and College Council. In so doing, address the following: Structure - Identify appropriate WCC pathway taskforce members as resources to the Student Success Committee; Strategy - Develop and recommend to the Senate and College Council a work plan for approval and submission to the CCCCO; Culture – Make recommendations to the Senate and College Council – Make implementation recommendations to the Senate and College Council within the context of existing WCC governance and Educational Master Planning framework; Communication – Develop and implement a WCC pathways webpage for internal and external consumption.
