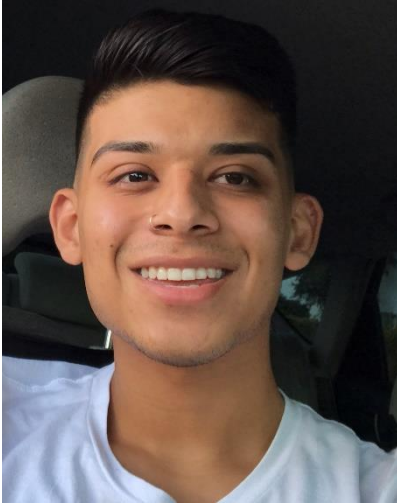


President
