Completion of all the requirements in the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will permit a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the California State University or the University of California system without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division, general education courses. All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" (or "P") or better. Advanced Placement (AP) examinations are appropriate for inclusion on the IGETC pattern.
