Introduction of Newly Tenured WCC Faculty

Once again thank you for the opportunity to introduce our newest WCC tenured faculty this evening. We, as a district, are fortunate to have these dedicated, student-centered educators in our ranks.

Supplemental Instruction (SI)

We recently received formal notification from the International Center for Supplemental Instruction out of the University of Missouri-Kansas City (UMKC) that the WCC Supplemental Instruction Program has met all the qualifications to be considered Accredited. The process for this accreditation was a three-year process. This is HUGE as WCC's SI program is only one of 5 community college SI programs accredited in the nation. This amazing recognition could not have been possible without the sustained hard work by our faculty and staff in the WCC student success center. Dr. Julie Collins (Executive Director of the International Center for Supplemental Instruction) stated in her communication to our program, "...there are many components of the program we were very impressed with, and we feel confident that your practices uphold the SI model and that your program is one for others to emulate."
