“If a problem can't be solved within the frame it was conceived, the solution lies in reframing the problem.”

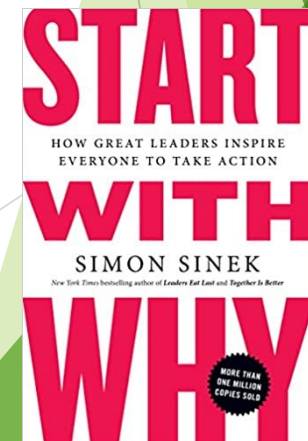

- Changes to the California Community College Mission (Dev Ed, AB 705)
- External Competitive Pressure from Education Alternatives
- Regional Depopulation from Natural Disasters, Rural Opportunity Index

How will the strategic choices we make in response help us shape the outcome the Lake County Campus and community desire?

Lake Enrollment & FTES Target

- State of California and Lake Stabilization (658 FTES)
- A return to standard funding for “Center Status” 250/500/750/1000 FTES
- Three Year Average 440 FTES, 250 to the 500 Tier represents \$337,000
- Strategy Goal of 540 Annual FTES, SP21 Planning for 250 FTES/22 FTEF
 - Scheduling traditionally main campus online offerings through the Lake Campus
 - Continuing the promotion of LCC offerings in service area from across the district
 - Opening renovated Welding and Business Spaces
 - Connecting and sharing the campus “Why” with students



Spring 2021 Schedule Development

- Conservative approach to Covid-19 with approximately 80% of courses online and 20% F2F, mostly in hard to convert or essential sectors

- Timeline

- Deans working on first draft with faculty input, first review on September 15
- Between September 18 and October 9, feedback from scheduling committee and second draft developed with deans and campus feedback
- October 9-16, deans submit staffing to scheduler for input into the system
- October 16, data is entered and schedule production begins
- October 26, schedule goes live- Registration begins November 16

Spring 2021 - Schedule

Will the college be producing a printed schedule of LCC courses? We love the newspaper!

- The newspaper was cool, but it has challenges
 - Staff time to produce, print, and distribute
 - Limited space for information
 - Unable to update dynamically, just think about the chaos a printed schedule would have created during summer and fall 2020 registration!
- Alternatives
 - Thoughtful and deliberate website redesign
 - Media Ads - Digital/Video and Postcards
 - 2-page front-and-back condensed flyer with key information driving to the website
