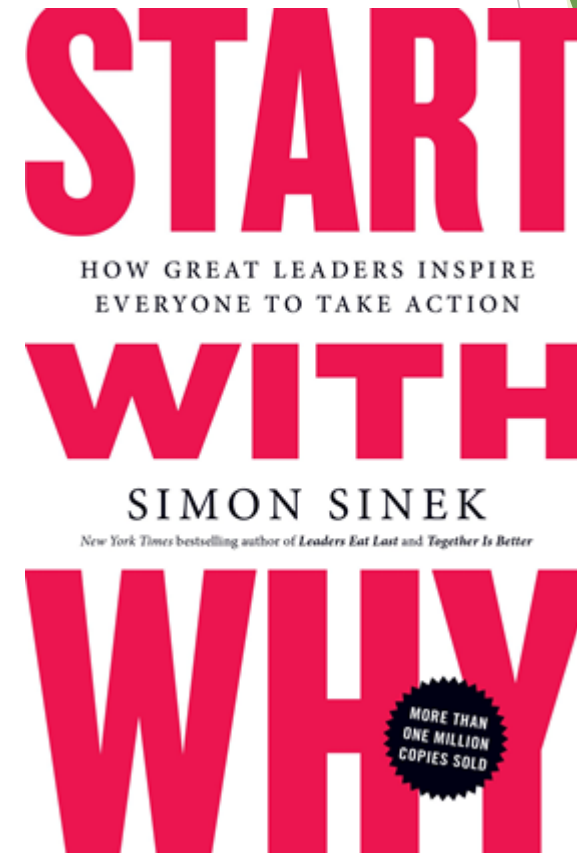

Appendix 1 What are we hearing in Lake?

- ▶ **Calls for a more unified approach to higher education in Lake County**
 - District/College Alignment
 - Outreach and Total Lake Portfolio
- ▶ **Challenges to the traditional model at Lake County Campus**
 - Basic skills in the aftermath of AB705 reforms
 - Course access online and the digital divide
 - Enrollment declines reducing program health and productivity
 - Pushing program limits to include commuting workers, evolving needs
- ▶ **Resource scarcity from students and the college**
 - Food pantry, hot spots, and laptop lending
 - Mental and behavioral health services
 - Need for short-term, intensive worker re-skilling
