



#### Instructional Modalities for Distance Education

#### **Fully Online:**

Course in which 100% of the instruction and interaction between instructor and student is done online asynchronously. Course has no listed dates and times for class sessions.

#### **Broadcast:**

Course offered through synchronous, 2-way interactive/point-to-point instruction (for example, via zoom) with listed times and dates.

#### **Hybrid:**

- Course that replaces some, but not all, face-to-face or synchronous online class time with asynchronous online instruction.
- Option A: teaching on-campus F2F and teaching online asynchronously.
- Option B: teaching synchronously via zoom and teaching online asynchronously.







