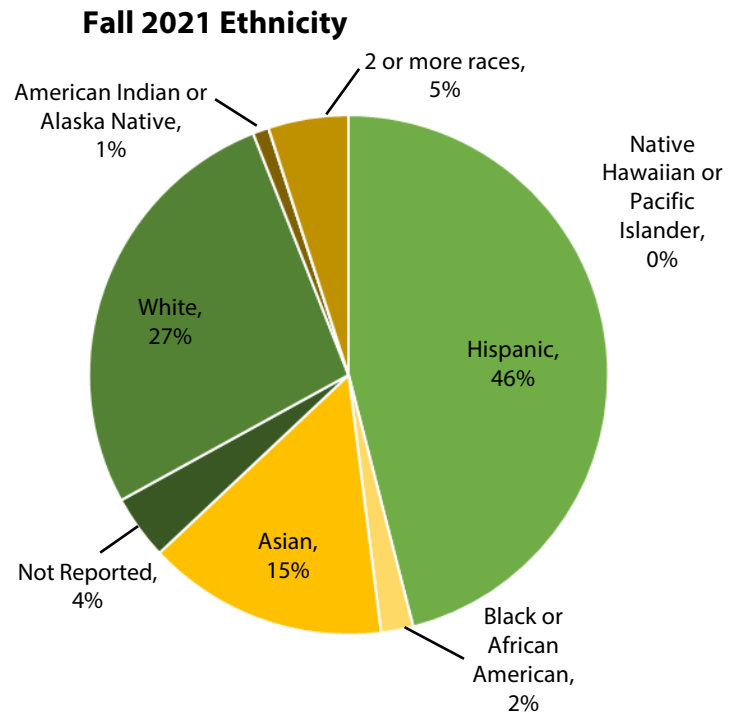
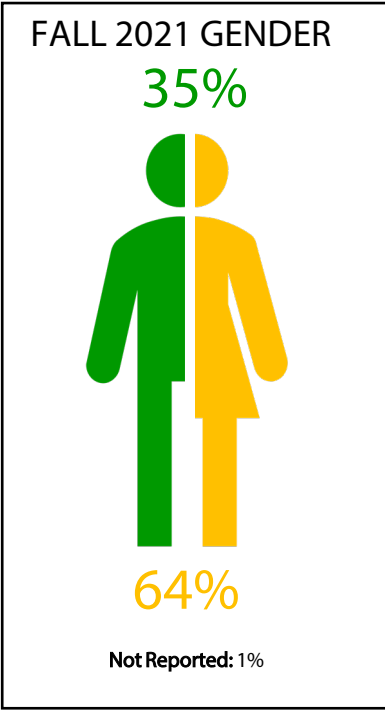
Woodland Community College was first established as an outreach center in 1975 and offered its first set of courses in the evening operating out of leased facilities. In 1981, the California Postsecondary Education Commission designated the outreach site as an official Education Center in the Yuba Community College District (YCCD). By 1985, the YCCD Board of Trustees had secured a 120-acre site in Woodland to establish the future College. In the 2020-21 year, WCC offered 26 certificates, 22 associate degrees, and 22 transfer degrees.
