





Degrees When Due Pilot



- ▶ Innovative, national completion initiative designed to improve student attainment rates through data driven strategies and tactics
- ▶ Undertaken to address the problem that 39 million adults across the US have earned some college, but no degree or certificate.
- ▶ Over 200 institutions of higher education have participated in 23 states
- ▶ YCCD was in California cohort 3 with UC Davis, Sac State, Sierra College and Los Rios

Impact

In the short-term ...

- ▶ Proactively identifying completers with FPAT reports during the term they are enrolled and encouraging students to petition for their awards.
- ▶ Nudging Fall 2021 Completers to Petition:
 - ▶ Identified 433 students that completed 569 awards
 - ▶ 59% (257) of those students received 330 awards
 - ▶ Contributing to a **32% increase in unduplicated students awarded and a 60% increase in awards conferred** when compared to Fall 2020



Impact

One year update ...

- ▶ During our first year of participation with DWD YCCD conferred over 2,000 additional awards to 1,578 students

What is Auto-Awarding?

- ▶ Auto-awarding is when an institution automatically issues (confers) associate degrees and certificates to students without a petition, application, or any other action by the student. It typically allows a student to opt-out prior to the award if they wish to do so.

5 CCR § 55063

§ 55063. Minimum Requirements for the Associate Degree.

The governing board of a community college district **shall** confer the associate degree upon a student who has demonstrated competence in reading, in written expression, and in mathematics, and who has satisfactorily completed at least 60 semester units or 90 quarter units of degree-applicable credit course work (as defined in section 55002(a)) which falls into the categories described in section 55062. A college may also accept toward satisfaction of this requirement courses that were not completed at a California community college that would reasonably be expected to meet or exceed the standards of section 55002(a).
