If it is critical, it could be

		included as an objective under broader EMP goal related to technology planning and leveraging technology to enhance access, success, and completion (e.g., enhancing the technology WCC already has to connect CCC to WCC for instruction and student support.
2017-2018 Objective: Increase certificate award rate by 20% on or before June 30, 2018.	Design, Execute, and Assess a Pilot Open Educational Resource (OER) Program - <b><i>In progress; Need to reassess this; Unclear if it should be a program or increase percentage of courses that are OER.</i></b>	<b>Recommend: This is an action item (as opposed to a goal) so do not include in EMP; Student Success Committee could potentially take this up.</b>
	Design, Execute, and Assess Comprehensive CCC Curriculum Enhancement as Identified in Gap Analysis - <b><i>Not complete; Can't have curriculum that is specific for one campus; Unclear if this is scheduling or delivery of curriculum.</i></b>	<b>Recommend: addressing the delivery/scheduling of curriculum, instructional programs at teaching sites and modalities can be incorporated in the strategic enrollment management plan (EMP Goal).</b>

Design, Execute, and Assess LCC and CCC Foundation Advisories.	Not completed	Recommend: Not clear what these “Foundation Advisories” are or their functions (financial foundation?); cannot make a recommendation on this item.
Design, Execute, and Assess WCC EMP with Associated Technology, Facility, and Staffing Plans	Program review, college collects requests, this helps inform technology plan, facility plan. Still in need for staffing plan. Some progress made	Note: recommended that EMP include implications for future technology, facility, and staffing; can also make the design and execution of technology, facility, and staffing plans an EMP goal.
